We are back on the road again after being at home for the last three months at our sending church. During that time, I flew to one meeting. The rest of my time was occupied by filling in as the Youth Pastor at my church, as you know from my last letter.

We had a great time getting to know the teens and teaching them from God's word. On Wednesday nights I taught a series of lessons on the churches of Macedonia, and on Sunday mornings we were going through lessons on God and his attributes. We also had a contest for 2 months where the teens could earn points by participating in what goes on at church, during that time a brother and sister that ride our bus to church, came to every service including every night of Missions conference. In the end the sister won 1st place for the girls and the brother won 2nd place for the boys. Our last Sunday one of the parents of the teens came and told us that they wished that we would stay because their sons had been enthusiastic about coming to church and were enjoying teen class.
